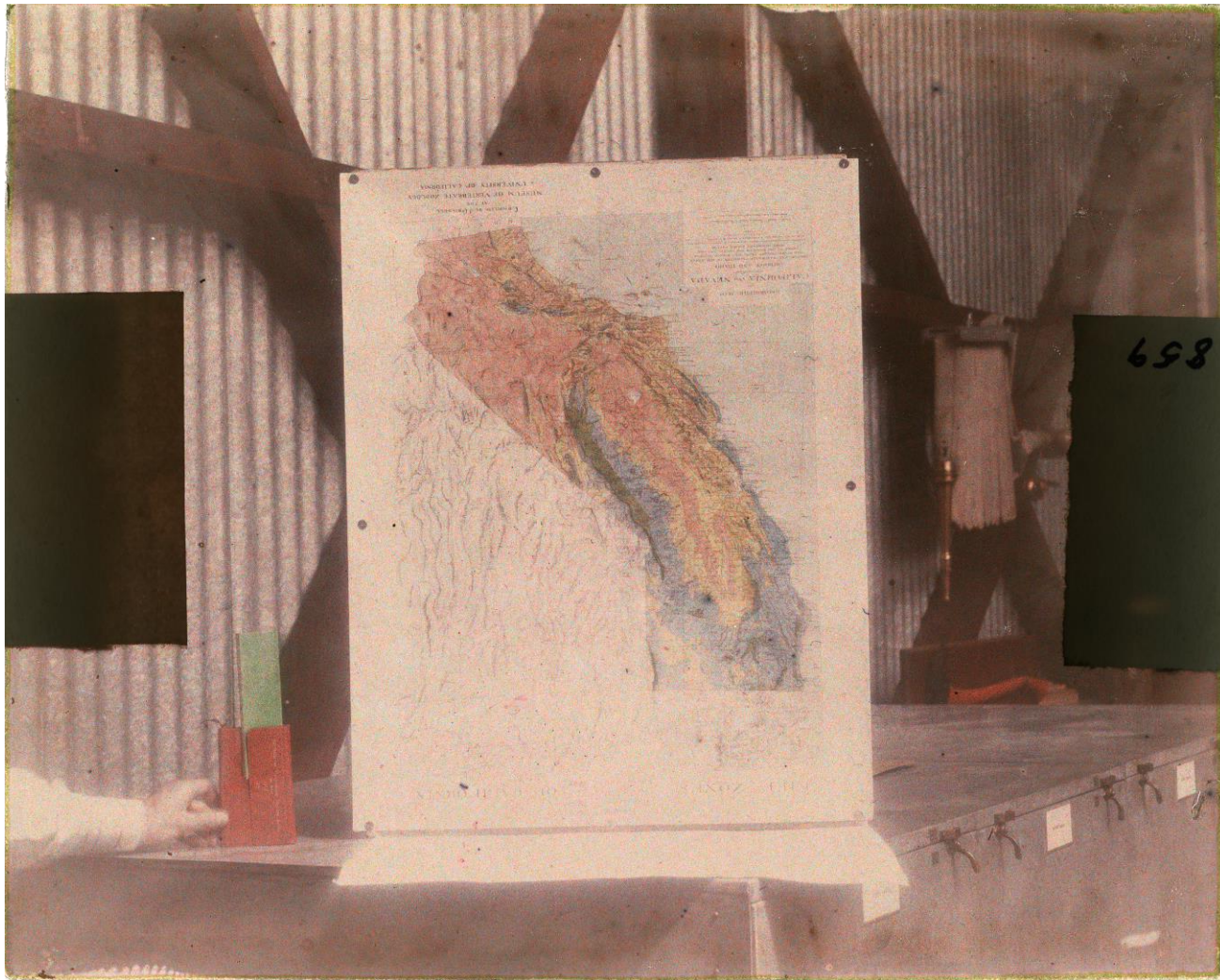

lt. eye



copper to golden.

gromphoses absent ventrally except 2 beneath tail & 2 beneath limbs proximally; gromphoses of dorsum of two sorts

(1) longer more branched pale powderblue & on less branched, more deeply situated silvery; on lipophanes about except scattered

Gromphane distribution

usually single well branched cells on eye lids and dorsum forming blotches on tail; proximal segments of limbs above Light Orange Yellow; spots on tail Mars Yellow; ventral surfaces Deep Neutral Gray, lightening in region of girdles, centrally in gular area, and beneath tail and under sides of feet;

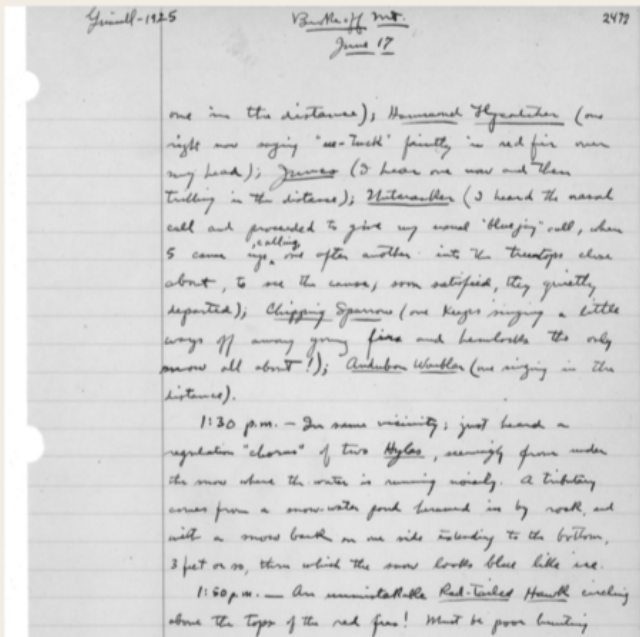

What is FromThePage?

FromThePage is free software that allows volunteers to transcribe handwritten documents online. It's easy to index and annotate subjects within a text using a simple, wiki-like mark-up. Users can discuss difficult writing or obscure words within a page to refine their transcription. The resulting text is hosted on the web, making documents easy to read and search.
