iNaturalist

Open the app and login to create an account.

5 Enter observation details and tap "Save"

Click "Upload" to submit your sightings to iNaturalist!

- Tap "More" then
 "Projects." Drag down
 to type in a search for
 Natural North Carolina
 and tap "Join." Repeat
 for other projects!
- 3 Tap "Observe"



Take or choose a photo and tap "Next"



iNaturalist now has image recognition! Tap on "What did you see?" and the app will suggest species if you are online. If nothing looks right, type in what you know about the species and click search, or browse. Click "Add" when vou've gotten as close as you can, but try not to guessleave this blank if you iust don't know!

Did this species get here on its own? If not, select "Yes."


Choose projects to share your observation with here. You will need to add them using the "Projects" button on the home screen before you can select them here. Choose Natural North Carolina and any other projects you like!






Select photos and drag and drop them into the window.
