




Euphrasia officinalis
Common Eyebright.
Clfsp. Didynamia
Order. Angiospermia
Gen: Char. Ovule 2. Capsule
egg shaped oblong, cells 2. One of the lobes
of the lower lip with a thorn at the
base
Spec: Char. Leaves egg shaped, streaked, sharply
toothed.
Blfls: 1 petal, gaping, bluish white, with purple
streaks
Found August 22nd 1793 at Gloucest. Cornwall
Obs: A: July. September.
Cows, Horses, Goats and Sheep eat it. soon
refuse it.
It is a weak antiseptic, and was formerly
in repute for improved vision. It will
not grow low when surrounded by plants
taller than itself.
