Workshop Transportation and Check-in:

We will have several vans to pick up participants from each hotel and transport them to the meeting site (Cornell Lab of Ornithology) or to an alternative site for activities on each morning. A schedule of morning events and van pick-up times will be sent separately. In addition, for those who might elect to skip a morning activity, each hotel has a shuttle that can bring you to the meeting site at the appropriate time. Meals and Other Related Activities:

Meals not provided as workshop functions will qualify for reimbursement at our per diem rate, see below for reimbursement procedures.

Ground Transport from the Hotel to the Ithaca Airport:

Reserve the complimentary airport shuttle at the hotel's front desk prior to your departure. You may wish to ride-share with other workshop participants. If the airport shuttle is not available, please take a taxi and be sure to retain receipts showing form of payment for later reimbursement by iDigBio.

Reimbursement Procedures:

Any meals not provided as workshop functions will be reimbursed at the state of Florida per diem rate (breakfast \$6, lunch \$11, dinner \$19); no receipts are needed. Mileage, taxi fares, parking fees, and baggage fees may qualify for reimbursement – please retain your original receipts showing form of payment.
