- What are the preferred standards and best practices?
 - What are the most important considerations for both field collecting and archival/ curation/management of bio-media?

Should preservation standards apply across the board?

- Should all bio-media that's accessioned/accepted by a collection be treated the same? Should standards be the same for all media types (photos/audio/video)?
- What about media associated with physical specimen VS rich media (with quality data) from citizen science/user contributed projects? Or camera traps/cams and passive acoustic monitors?
- Are there reasons for "lightly curated" media collections (for teaching/outreach/education or other?)
 If so, what are they?

Impacts on sustainability?

- Costs of inaction on preservation (analog vs digital)? Backlogs rarely require fewer resources and that has a potential cost on assets already being curated.
- But there are also costs of action too. Long term storage, management and curation of media will always major resources even as certain costs (e.g. storage) go down).
- What is the relationship between preservation standards and long-term sustainability? How are the considerations different for different types of collections?
- What are the "business models" and funding sources to keep digital asset management and digital preservation operations current?
- Does it make sense to partnering with or use commercial services or other specialized institutional operations for sustainability reasons?
