Why Digitize?

- Safeguard information against catastrophes
- Share biodiversity information worldwide
- Promote general interest in collections
- Ease of use for the particular institution
- Reducing risk to specimens themselves

- 160/244 started databasing
- 58/244 imaging
- ~15% online access

- Arkansas State University Herbarium (STAR)
 - 20,000 specimens
 - No funding
 - 2 year time scale

- Annotating
 - Checking nomeclature only
 - 1 Person → Approx. 150 specimens per hour




- Imaging:
 - 1 person > 143 images/hour
 - 2 people > 160 images/hour







Specimens per Hour - Kari



Specimens per Hour - Alex



- Databasing:
 - 1 Person
 30 specimens/hour



- 1 person;10 hours/week; 20,000 specimens:
 - 13 weeks to annotate
 - 13 weeks to image
 - 67 weeks to database
- Total: 93 weeks or ~ 2 years
