#### **Announcements**

- Molly Phillips will be out for 3 months on maternity leave, starting late June
- In iDigBio's new cooperative agreement, NSF changed the name of the Internal Advisory Committee to the Stakeholder Engagement Forum. Although iDigBio acknowledges this in the Cooperative Agreement, we prefer to maintain the current name for continuity. David Jennings will communicate this to Roland and Reed.

#### **TCN Orientation Meetings - Neil Cobb**

- Neil would prefer to not have TCN orientation at the Summit. LepNet did not have enough time to get through everything they needed to.
- Cindy Skema (MAM) and Bruce Lieberman (CW) were under the impression that only the PI's needed to attend the Summit, not that the orientation must take place there.
- · David Jenningswill talk with Roland/Reed and find out if kickoff meetings are required to be held at the Summit. We agree that there are two levels of orientation – one for the TCN and one for integrating new TCNs into iDigBio and ADBC

#### iDigBio/ADBC Orientation - David Jennings



- iDigBio has been entertaining the idea of having a virtual orientation for integrating new TCNs into iDigBio and ADBC
- This would be held online sometime prior to the Summit but after the new TCNs are announced
- TCN representatives thought this is a great idea
- Everyone suggested recording the orientation session for future broadcast

#### **Summit 2017**

- Dates: November 2 & 3; Meeting day: November 1; potential field trips on November 4
- Venue: UF Cultural Arts Plaza in Gainesville, FL
  - Highlighting the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Florida Museum of Natural History
  - Saves iDigBio a lot of money for internal travel support
- Special events this year
  - o iDigBio is working with the UF Informatics Institute to hold a two-day Data Carpentry workshop on the Monday and Tuesday prior to the Summit
  - o National Fossil Day is being celebrated at the Florida Museum on Saturday, November 4, which will include special exhibits. iDigBio is considering a guest speaker for Friday night and possibly a fossil-related field trip on Saturday.
  - o iDigBio is looking at other field trip opportunities on Saturday as well
- TCN representatives liked the idea of a funding cap for reimbursement
  - iDigBio is also advocating hotel room sharing (as we have done in the past)
- The recommendation was made to invite 2-3 Pl's from each TCN, preferably from 2 different institutions.
  - PEN's should be invited once to make them feel included in the community perhaps all new PENs are invited to come to the Summit from now on?
  - Others expressed the desire to invite students to attend
- Action item: Start thinking about who you would invite from your TCN.

#### **Expanding Stakeholders - Deb Paul**

- Deb asked TCN representatives to brainstorm potential audiences for iDigBio to reach out to when visiting your institution, to increase awareness in different departments.
- · Concern was voiced over TCN awareness of iDigBio travel. Although it is on the iDigBio calendar, Petra recommended a briefing at the beginning of IAC meetings to inform representatives of where Gil, Deb, and others will be traveling so they can plan accordingly.

#### Georeferencing

- Petra voiced her struggle with georeferencing. She will be having georefrencing component at her upcoming Mollusk workshop in July 2017
  - Sharon Grant at the Field Museum took a Train-the-Trainers workshop, so she could be tapped to lead.
- Michael Denslow Has a plug-in for Symbiota to make georeferencing more efficient. Collaborative tool with Geolocate
- Hopefully in the future Biospex will allow for specimens to be more easily transcribed and geolocated



Biospex should be thought of like middleware to connect your portal to other software like
Notes from Nature, Geolocate, etc.

## **Community Survey - Shari Ellis**

- Shari expressed that it is important for everyone (i.e., all TCN participants) to take the community survey when it comes out later this year
- The survey is NOT limited to only one response per institution, TCN, or PEN more participation is better
