Collections registration / data ingestion

[Joanna McCaffrey] There are more institutions submitting data than assumed. The process can be partially automated, but we will need additional information. Got some data from Alex Thompson, she will send the institution list to the TCN's for review, please let her know if anything is missing.

[Neil Cobb] If you let us know what you need, we can add it to our Symbiota entries.

Notes from Nature: Citizen Science and crowd sourcing. NFN needs dedicated support for cleanup.

[Dena Smith] Would like to figure out the resources needed to participate in Notes from Nature.

[Barbara Thiers] The New York Botanical Gardens was running a volunteer program, where they train incarcerated people to do the data entry. A limitation to crowd sourcing is that only basic data will be usable for the general public, information like Taxonomic names will not be included. Maybe if training workshops are provided it will improve the "grade" of the data.

[Katja Seltmann] We have been using another portal (Discover Life) for data entry – I will probably do a poster / demo for Summit III.

Anyone using/ has an interest in using voice input via Dragon Technology? There will be a demo of this at the upcoming Paleo Digitization Workshop (September 23-26) at Yale.

[Katja Seltmann] Could voice input be a Summit III topic? Susan Butts has experience and will be attending Summit. [Patrick Sweeney] Would be nice to get feedback on the challenges/ success people are having with using this technology.

[Joanna McCaffrey] Seeking information of the estimated costs of digitizing - Can it be done?

[Katja Seltmann] Depends on what type of digitization is being done – cost will depend on if the data will be skeletal of detailed.

[Robert Naczi] The information would be useful to know but would vary greatly with each type of specimen.
